# **Wivenhoe Sailing Club Centenary Cake Competition**

## Adults – 2 Categories

## 1) DESIGN

To create a cake topped with a design on the theme of the Wivenhoe Sailing Club Centenary.

The cakes will be judged on the design and overall presentation.

The cakes are to be a minimum of 18cm (7inches) in diameter or square.

All cakes in this category will be on display on the afternoon of the Wivenhoe Regatta –  $12^{th}$  July (except during the period of judging.)

All cakes will be photographed and a display created at the club later in the year.

### Prize

The winning design will be used as a logo at the entrance to the club, and featured in the next edition of the Wivenhoe News, and other media outlets. The winner will also receive an engraved award.

# 2) FAVOURITE CAKES

Cakes in this category may be any shape or size (including traybakes.)

The cakes will be judged on Presentation, Texture and Flavour (each category to have equal weighting.)

#### Prize

The person baking the cake judged best in this class will receive an engraved award.

Junior Category – aged up to 12 years.

# 1) Cakes or Muffins in a Case or Scones

Children to provide a set of between 3 and 6 cakes/muffins or scones.

The entries will be judged on Presentation, Texture and Flavour (each category to have equal weighting.)

### Prize

The person baking the cake judged best in this class will receive an engraved award

## **General Rules and Information**

All entries must be registered between 11:30am and 1pm on Wivenhoe Regatta Day, 12<sup>th</sup> July. Entries will be given a number – and the judges will not know the names of the people who have entered to avoid bias.

Judging will take place between 2:15pm and 3:15pm, with prize-giving at 3:30pm.

If you are happy to donate your cake to the club for consumption at the club's Open Day on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> July, the club will cover the cost of your ingredients up to the value of £5 (£2 for Children's entries.) If you do this, you must provide a full list of ingredients in order that we can display a list of allergens.

If you are taking your cake away, Favourite Cakes & Children's entries may be taken after prize-giving. The Design category will remain on display for the afternoon and may be collected between 5pm and 6pm.
